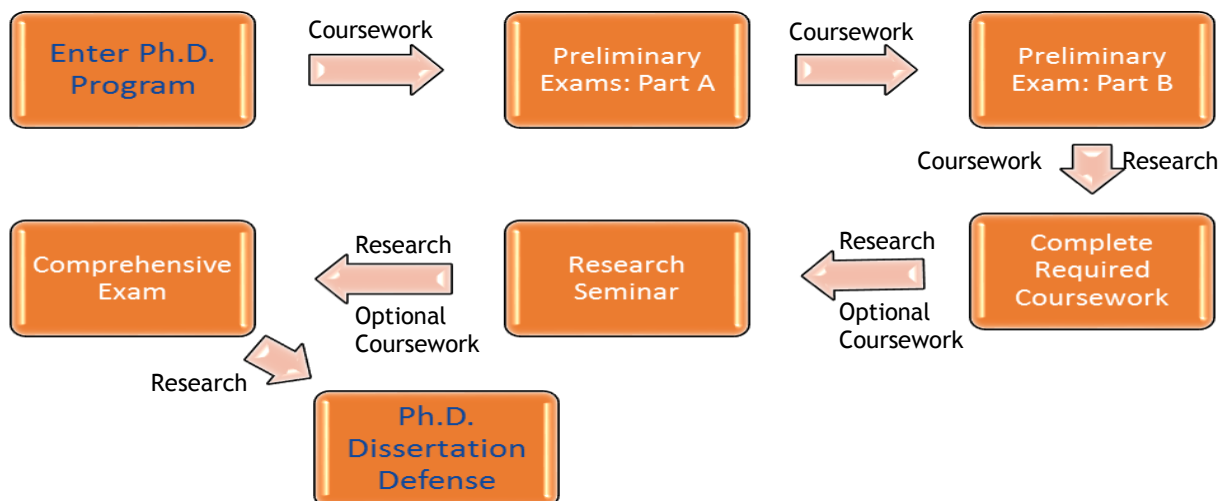


DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY DEGREE IN MATHEMATICS

PH.D. PROGRAM OF STUDY

Doctoral degree programs are offered in Mathematics and in Statistics in either the Ph.D. track (4 years of study; for students with master's degree) or the B.S-Ph.D. track (5 years of study; for students with bachelor's degree only).
